Dear Prime Minister,

Ref: Demonstrations in Iran against the Islamic Republic.

The Association of Iranian Human Rights and Allies would like to take this opportunity in congratulating you on becoming the Prime Minister of the United Kingdom.

The world is now witnessing a homegrown revolution in Iran. This organic revolution has now entered its sixth week.

Since the murder of the young 22-year-old Mahsa Amini by the Islamic Republic's morality police, mass protests for women's rights as well as calls for the downfall of the Islamic Republic have spread to over 200 Iranian towns and cities.

The Islamic Republic has responded with a brutal crackdown. Many other young Iranians have now died in the demonstrations or custody. Many thousands are now missing.

On a daily basis, we are witnessing gross violations of Human Rights. Live ammunition is discharged into crowds, snipers are killing protestors with 'head shots' and some are beaten to death with batons in the streets. The protestors are being tortured in custody. Young girls are raped. Iranian medics are forced to falsify death certificates and rape cases have to be documented as 'bloody diarrhea. More recently, the Islamic Republic has started to kidnap young teenage girls from the streets of Iran.

These actions are unacceptable and reprehensible and the democracies in the world need to make a firm stance regarding these criminal and violent acts.

Great Britain has been the leader as well as the defender of equality, fairness, and human rights.

Prime Minister, it is now time that Great Britain, in the interest and protection of freedom, democracy, and human rights, stands in solidarity with the Iranian protestors as well as its allies.

The Canadian government has introduced sweeping sanctions against the Islamic Republic and we hope that in the interest of Human Rights and freedom, all Western democracies will consider holding the Islamic Republic to account by condemning their brutal conduct as well as putting words into action with sanctions that will force Tehran to reconsider its conduct against unarmed civilians, who are mostly young teenagers and students.

On 10th August 2022 during the Westminster North Husting, you correctly and accurately discussed with the Conservative Party members present that it is pointless to cut off the tentacles of an octopus and that we must kill it by cutting the head off, referring to the Islamic Republic of Iran and its proxy forces in the near East. Now, more than ever, the international community must act against the Islamic Republic by supporting the Iranian people.

Sources from the near East indicate that family members of the Islamic Republic government officials are leaving the country. This is to be viewed as positive news and we urge the United Kingdom and her allies to be vigilant, ensuring criminals that may be a part of this small exodus responsible for crimes against humanity are brought to trial.
